

LOCATION

Eastern Caribbean. Antigua and Barbuda lie in the eastern arc of the Leeward Islands and the Lesser Antilles, separating the Atlantic Ocean from the Caribbean Sea. 650 km southeast of Puerto Rico, Barbuda lies 48 km due north of Antigua.

CLIMATE

Antigua and Barbuda have a sub-tropical climate. The average daily temperature drops a few degrees in winter (December to March) from the usual high of around 81°F (27°C). Antigua and Barbuda are fairly dry throughout most of the year except during the rainy season (mid-September to November) when daily showers can be expected.

CURRENCY

Eastern Caribbean Dollar. The U.S. Dollar is widely accepted.

ELECTRICITY

110 volts/60cycles; US outlets

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Visitors require a valid passport, a return or onward ticket, confirmation of accommodation throughout the stay and sufficient funds for the duration of the stay.

PETS


