





Our passion for the sea is boundless. Nautical traditions and a reliance on the sea made boat racing Anguilla's national sport and year round pastime.

We have 33 beaches including Shoal Bay East, ranked among the most beautiful in the world. Sun. Swim. Snorkel. Or pull anchor. Prickly Pear, Sandy Island and Scilly Cay are only a sailboat away. Take a glass bottom boat. A moonlight cruise. Or a deep breath. And hold it. With little or no underwater current, diving here is ideal for beginners.


A unique marine structure comprises two systems – an 'inside reef' and an 'outside reef'. Shallow dives begin at 35 feet. Go under and see soft corals. Sea fan. Gorgonian sponges. Sea wipes.

The Underwater Museum and her Spanish Galleon, 'El Buen Consejo'. Our deepest site at 120 feet. We have nine wrecks covered with copious amounts of hard corals. Giant Brain. Pencil. Flower. Elkhorn. Plaque. And schools of fish. Swimming to you.

Even the beaches are glossy on small, coraline Anguilla.... Offshore, a limestone ridge attracts small tropical fish and novice snorkelers...

You can register in English, French, Spanish, Russian, German or Chinese. And to facilitate the banking community, company status and name availability search portals are on our public website www.axafc.com.





Anguilla has a subtropical climate where the trade winds blow to maintain the humidity and heat at a comfortable level. The average temperature is 80° F (27°C) and the annual rainfall is about 36 inches.

CURRENCY

Eastern Caribbean Dollar. The U.S. Dollar is widely accepted.

DRIVING

On the left. Valid license from resident country required to obtain a temporary Anguillian drivers license for \$20.00US that is issued on the spot by car rental agencies.

ELECTRICITY

110 volts/60 cycles; U.S. outlets

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Valid passports are recommended. An original birth certificate with a raised seal or a certified copy together with photo identification is also acceptable.
